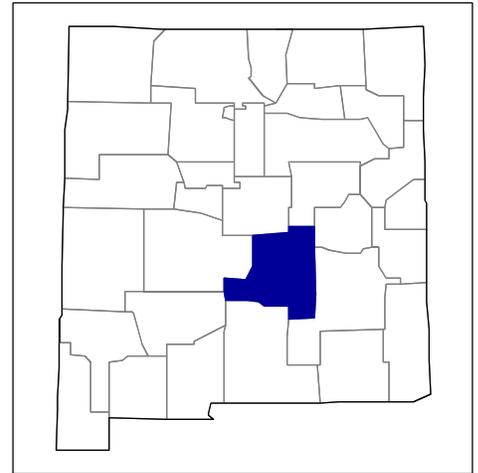


# 2002 Census of Agriculture County Profile

## Lincoln, New Mexico



### Number of farms

343 farms in 2002, 448 farms in 1997, down 23 percent.

### Land in farms

1,605,566 acres in 2002, 1,987,732 acres in 1997, down 19 percent.

### Average size of farm

4,681 acres in 2002, 4,437 acres in 1997, up 5 percent.

### Market Value of Production

\$11,116,000 in 2002, \$14,386,000 in 1997, down 23 percent.

Crop sales accounted for \$235,000 of the total value in 2002.

Livestock sales accounted for \$10,880,000 of the total value in 2002.

### Market Value of Production, average per farm

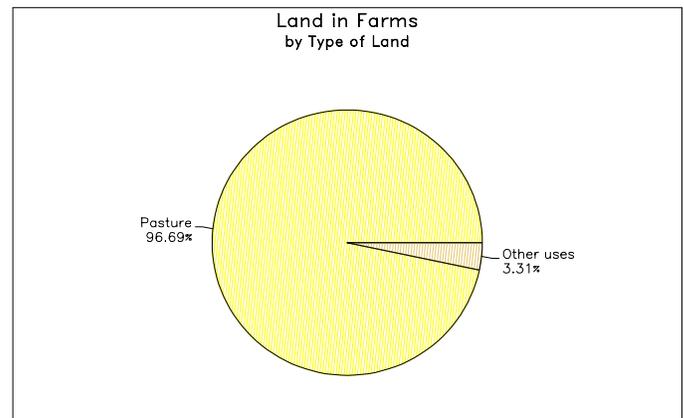
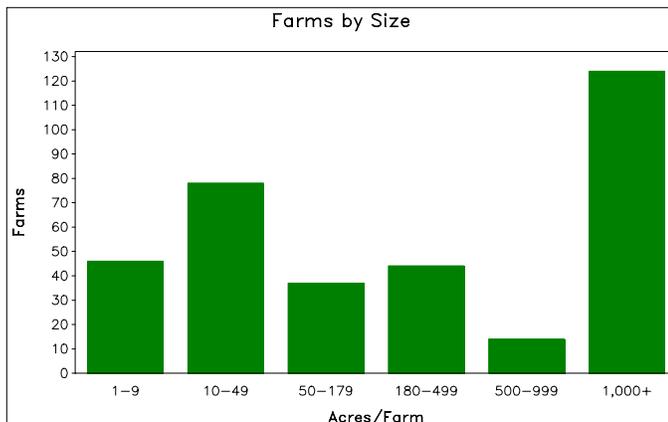
\$32,407 in 2002, \$32,112 in 1997, up 1 percent.
