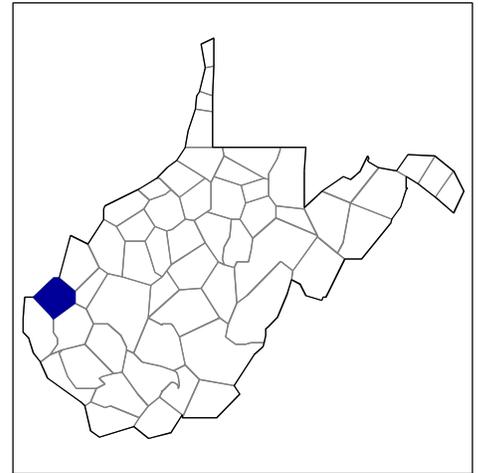


# 2002 Census of Agriculture County Profile

## Cabell, West Virginia

### Market Value of Production

\$2,970,000 in 2002, \$2,555,000 in 1997, up 16 percent.

Crop sales accounted for \$2,345,000 of the total value in 2002.

Livestock sales accounted for \$626,000 of the total value in 2002.

### Market Value of Production, average per farm

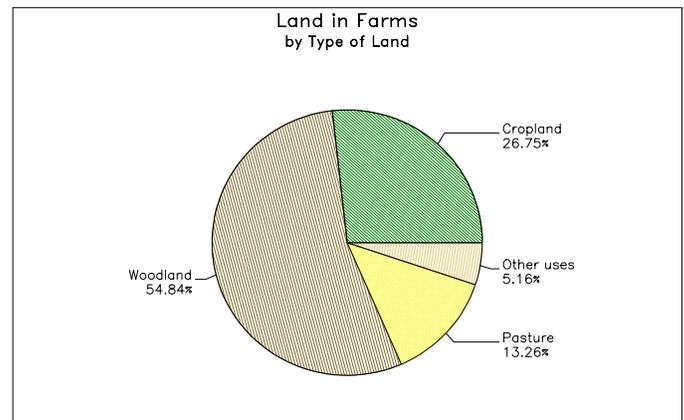
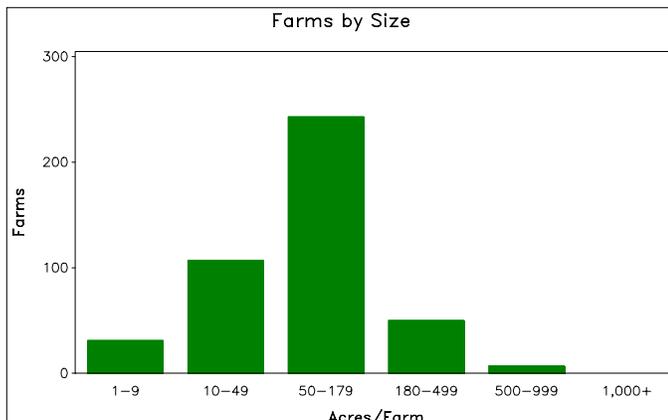
\$6,782 in 2002, \$6,585 in 1997, up 3 percent.
