#### Market Value of Production, average per farm

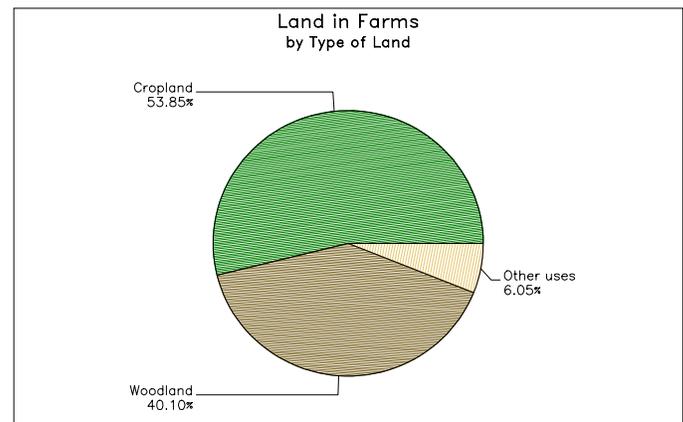
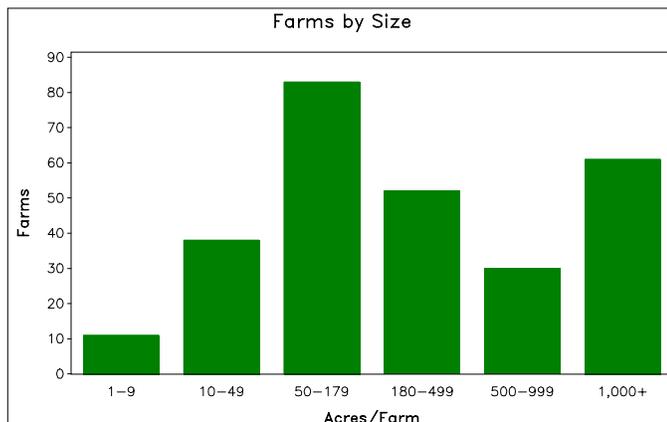
\$127,279 in 2002, \$182,710 in 1997, down 30 percent.
