Organic Highlights

In 2014, the United States had 14,093 organic farms producing \$5.5 billion in organic products. The number of organic farms varies across the country. Wyoming had 49 organic farms that produced \$16.7 million in total value of organic products sold.

Of the 49 organic farms identified in the 2014 Organic Survey for Wyoming, 49 were certified organic. There were 17 farms with 100 percent total value of sales from certified organic production, compared to 21 farms with 75 to 99 percent, 8 farms with 50 to 74 percent, and 3 farms with 25 to 49 percent.

The 2014 Organic Survey provides acreage, production, and sales data for a variety of organic crops and inventory and sales data for organic livestock commodities. The 2014 survey collected data from U.S. farms and ranches that were certified organic, exempt from organic certification, or transitioning to organic certification. This survey was done in conjunction with the USDA’s Risk Management Agency to aid in improving insurance products for organic agriculture.
