




### East Feliciana Parish - Louisiana Farms with Spanish, Hispanic, or Latino Operators Compared with All Farms







### East Feliciana Parish - Louisiana Farms with Asian Operators Compared with All Farms



### East Feliciana Parish - Louisiana Farms with Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander Operators Compared with All Farms





